Dear Parents and Carers,

Spring has Sprung – Return to School!

Thank you for being so respectful, courteous and polite towards each other during the sessions

Whilst we can't wait for all the children to come back to school on 8 March, we understand that some children – and parents – may be experiencing a range of emotions in relation to this and would encourage you to talk to us if you have any concerns. Next week, I will be sharing a short survey for you to complete to help make us aware of how emotionally ready your child/ren are for the return to school and to help us plan and prepare accordingly. Thank you for engaging so well with the online surveys and consent forms – it is a huge time saver all round.

In addition (as was offered in the final week of the summer holidays) if there are any families who have not been in school since before Christmas who would like the opportunity to visit and see the measures that we have put in place, we would welcome you to make an appointment out of school hours next week. Further details will follow under separate cover early next week confirming the logistical and staffing arrangements for the full reopening of school. We do not anticipate many changes to the systems we had in place during the Autumn Term. We will be resuming our staggered start and finish times as previously. Hot meals will be provided for all children who request one. There will be two days during the week where children will need to come dressed in PE kits (days to be confirmed for each class). One of the main changes we have implemented this term is that staff now wear face coverings when moving around the school building – you may wish to prepare your child/ren for this if they have not been in school to see that this term.


Message for Class 4: Mrs Chandler – Curriculum Training on Tuesday 2 March
