Dinner Money – Price Increase

Please note that with effect from September 2021, the cost for a school meal will rise to £2.70 per day (a 5p per day increase on current rates). This is as a result of raised charges from North Yorkshire County Council catering services. This will apply to all children from Year 3 to Year 6 (Classes 3 and 4) from September unless you qualify for Free School Meals.

If your financial circumstances have changed and you feel that you may now be eligible for Pupil Premium, please do not hesitate to contact either myself or Mrs Bacon for a confidential discussion. Pupil Premium funding brings financial benefits both to yourself and to us as a school.
