Dear Parents and Carers,

As we complete the end of our first full week of term, I would like to extend an enormous well done to everyone. The children have settled remarkably well and it's absolutely amazing to see them enjoying playing, learning and eating together once again.

News from school this week

Reading - Message from Mrs Rayner English Subject Leader

We have invested in a new phonics scheme which children in Class 1 and 2 have been enjoying this week. Class 1 will soon be starting to bring 'wordless' books home to share with an adult, to help develop their language and story sequencing skills. These will be sent on a Friday and must be returned the following Friday. Children in Class 2 will start to bring one book home per week every Friday, from next week. This book closely matches the sounds taught in phonics and your child should be able to read most of it independently, to an adult. This way, the children can develop their fluency and reading for pleasure, whilst we are teaching them to read in school. Please ensure that the books are returned the following Friday, as they are also used in school for reading practise sessions with other children. There will be more information out on these changes later in the term. Children in Class 3 can change their book on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Children in Class 4 can change their book as needed.

Homework

Classes 2-4: We would like to keep the children's skills up of using Google Classroom, so we are continuing to use the class websites as the 'hub' for their homework tasks. These will be set on a Thursday and due the following Thursday. Please ask your child to log in, as their first homework task was set yesterday and is due in on Thursday 23 September. There is an expectation that homework will be completed regularly, on time and to a good standard. If you are struggling with any aspect of this, please do get in touch with your child's class teacher in the first instance.

Children in Class 1 will use a homework book until the summer term.



On Tuesday 21st September, we are welcoming Skip2Bfit into school. They will be running skipping workshops for all of the children and staff in school. Skipping teaches the fundamentals of sport, balance, timing and footwork. The children will be challenged throughout the session and prizes will be awarded during a special assembly at the end of the day. We are using our Sports Premium Funding to fund this fun,

active and motivating day. We are also buying each child a skipping rope which has an inbuilt counter. We will use the ropes at breaktimes, during skipping club and for our sponsored skipathon – more details to follow shortly. The children will write an article for next week's Chronicle.
