Important information about this afternoon's event:

- You will be admitted to the playground via Apple Class' outdoor area from 2:30pm

- Hot drinks are available for adults – “takeaway cups” have been kindly provided by Curious Coffee of Easingwold (thanks to Mrs Bacon for sorting this!)
- The children will be proudly displaying their “Jubilee Crowns” and will also each be presented with a mug from the village.
- We will conclude the celebrations with a performance of the National Anthem at 3:15pm, which the children have been learning in school. **Please feel free to join in!**
- After this, we will ask you to move to the normal collection zone in the staff car park.
- Children will return into school to pick up their belongings and they will be available for collection at the usual end of day time.

Free School Meals

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following:

- o Income Support
- o Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- o Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- o Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- o The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- o Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
 - o Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- o Universal Credit – if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If you think you meet any of the criteria above then please apply by completing the attached application form and send it directly to; The Welfare Team, CYPS, Jesmond House, 31/33 Victoria Avenue, Harrogate, HG1 5QE. Applications are usually processed within five working days.

They will notify you either by writing, post or email if your child is entitled to receive this funding. School will also be informed.

Free school meals claims cannot be backdated. They are awarded from the date the application is received, once eligibility is confirmed. This is because there is a legal requirement for a request to be made, before free school meals can be provided.

Registering for free school meals could also raise an extra £1,345 pupil premium funding for the school to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities and trips. Please contact either myself or Mrs Bacon if you have any queries regarding the application process.

With the school fair just a few weeks away here's how you can help make it an awesome day.

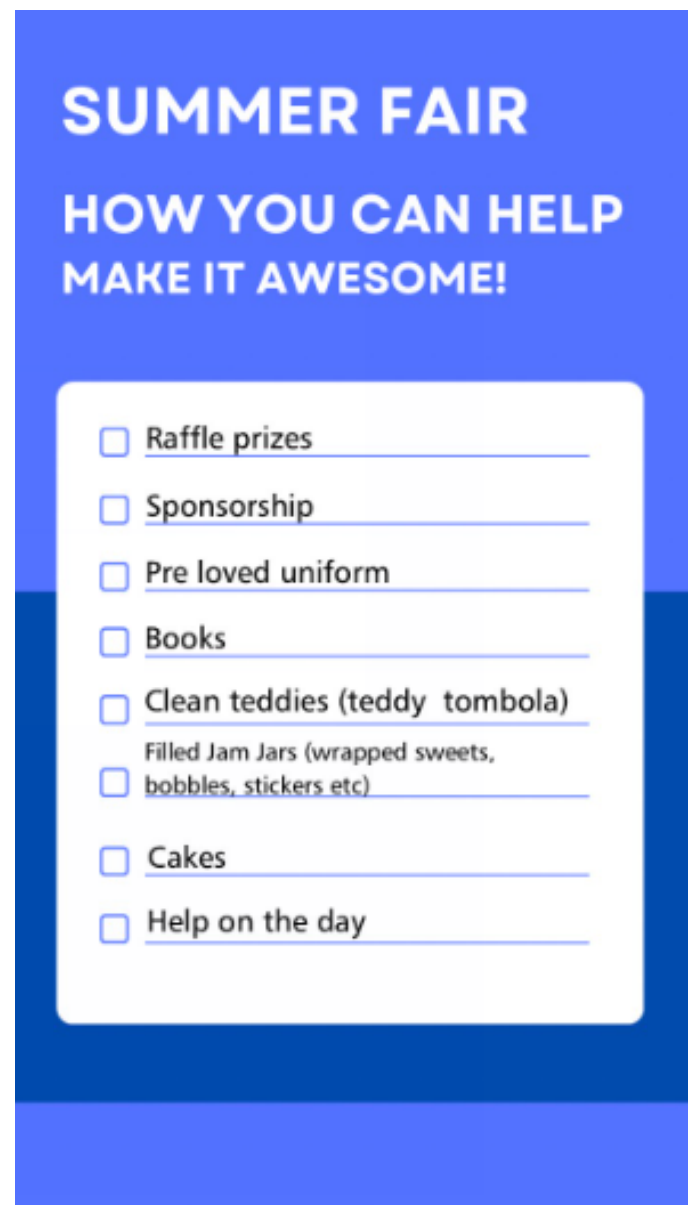
