Physical Development

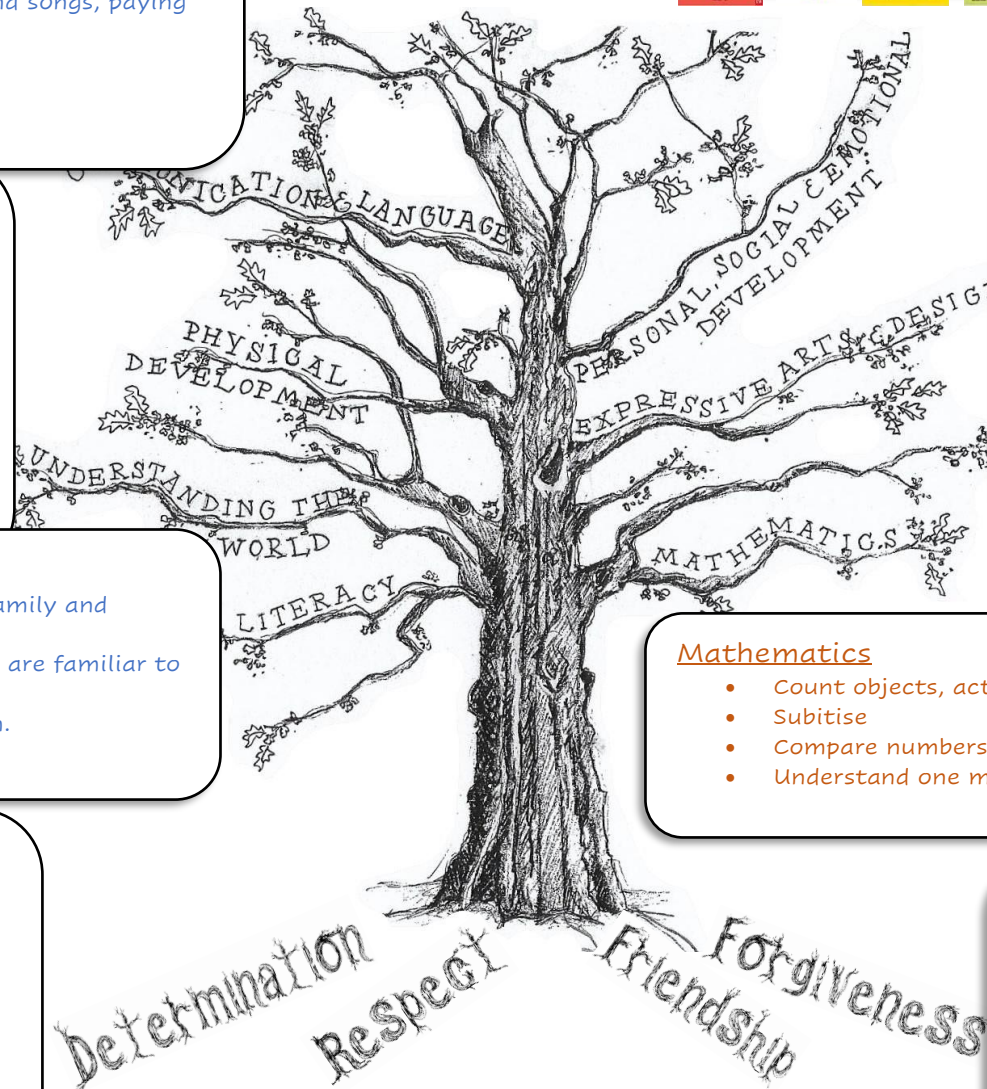
- Spatial awareness (Aut 1)
