#### News from School this week

#### **Dinner Money Cost Increase from September 2025**

We have been informed by our Catering supplier - NYES Catering - that regrettably, our school meal cost will increase again this year, from £3.64 to £3.93 per day from September 2025. The meal cost to parents is currently £3.50 and school subsidise the remaining cost. Unfortunately, with the current economic climate and the increased employer national insurance contributions from April this year, this increase has been unavoidable.

This was discussed at the last Governor's finance meeting and it was agreed that the school budget would continue to subsidise the cost of school meals from 1 September. Therefore, the cost of a school meal to parents/carers will be £3.80 for children in KS2 (Years 3-6) from the start of the new academic year.




#### SPORTS DAY – 4 JULY 2024


#### ANNUAL REPORTS - w/c 14 JULY 2025
